

Parking IS available at St. Peters!!!

Saturday & Sundays

Parishioners may use the Catholic Center lot (formerly convent lot) for Mass on Saturday nights, Sunday mornings and Holy Days. (#2 on map) The gate will be open as you enter for weekend masses. **It will be closed as you leave but will open automatically as you approach it to exit.** Please use designated spaces and don't block others in!

Street parking is available on many nearby streets. These spaces are metered on weekdays and Saturdays. Meter payment is not required on Sundays.

Parishioners are allowed to park on Somerset St. in front of the Vue building (#4 on map) on Sundays (**but not Saturdays**), despite signs to the contrary. Do not park in the intersection of Somerset and College Ave. or you will be ticketed!

The parish has vouchers for use in the Gateway Transit parking deck of the Vue building (#1 on map). They provide up to four hours of free parking. You have to pay thereafter. **Detailed instructions on how to use the parking deck and vouchers is on the reverse of this sheet.** They will be distributed after every Mass by the priest and ushers who will be available outside the front of the church.

Although the gates are up at Rutgers lots on weekends, and there is no guard at the Kirkpatrick lot, we are told that the Campus Police may ticket anyone without a Rutgers sticker. Park in these lots at your own risk!

We ask that all those who are able, to park in the Gateway deck (with vouchers) so that our elderly and handicapped parishioners can use the lots and street parking.
Handicapped designated parking spaces are available at all locations.

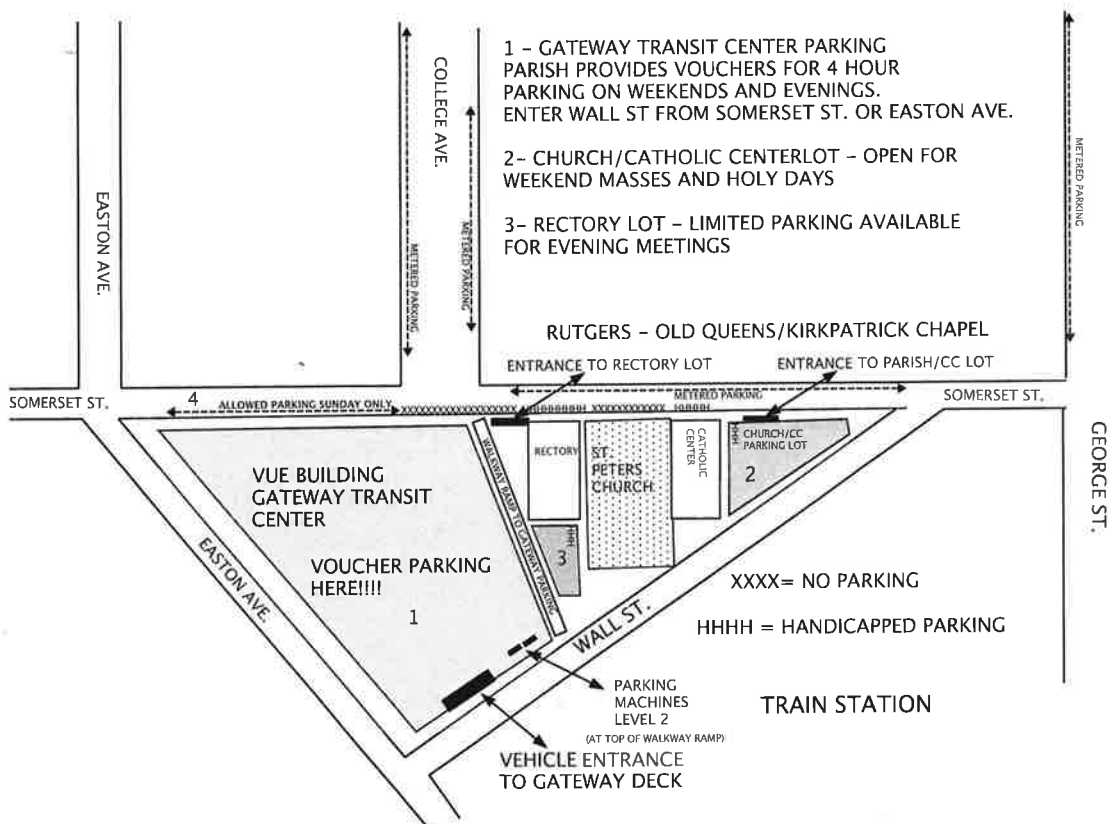
Weekdays & Weeknights

Those who are able should park in the Gateway Transit deck (#1 on the map) when attending meetings or events on weekday evenings. See info above and on reverse regarding the Gateway Deck and parking vouchers. The person convening your event/meeting will have vouchers for you

If you cannot use the deck, you may park in the rectory lot (#3 on map) providing you do not block anyone in.

You may also park in the Catholic Center lot (#2 on map). On weekdays and weeknights the entry gate will be down. You need to speak into the intercom at the gate and state your parish business so that the attendant inside the Catholic Center can grant you access. **The gate will be closed as you leave, but will open automatically as you approach it to exit.** Please use designated spaces and don't block others in!

Handicapped designated parking spaces are available at all locations.



Instructions for Parking at the Gateway Transit Village Parking Deck

Entering and Parking:

1. Enter the parking deck from the entrance off of Wall Street (the street between the church and the train tracks).
2. Push the green button at the gate to receive a "ticket" which will indicate the date and time you entered the deck.
3. Drive up the parking deck to an available parking space and take note of the floor where you parked. **Do not park in parking spaces that are clearly marked as reserved.** If you park in one of those spaces, you may be fined for parking illegally.
4. On the lower floors there are spaces reserved for 2 hours. They are electronically monitored so don't park there for more than 2 hours.
5. Bring the ticket with you and keep it in a secure place because you will need to validate it prior to returning to your car.
6. Take the elevators on the Wall ST. side to the "WALKWAY" on Floor #2. (Do NOT go all the way down). The walkway will lead you to Somerset St next to the rectory.

Validating and Exiting the Parking Deck:

7. Obtain a "voucher" from one of the priests or their designees (ushers, readers, etc.). The voucher will be approximately the same size as the ticket you received as you entered the deck. The voucher will only have a bar code on it. The ticket will have a bar code plus other writing on it including "Gateway Transit Village".
8. Prior to returning to your car, stop at one of the automated attendant machines on the second floor, which is at the top of the walkway that leads to the train station.
9. Insert the ticket which you received when you entered the parking deck into the slot indicated on the machine (marked as "Step 1" on the machine). The ticket will be taken into the machine and an amount due should appear on the screen. SEE PHOTO #1 BELOW
10. **DO NOT PUT THE VOUCHER YOU GOT AT CHURCH IN SLOT FOR STEP #1 WHERE YOU PUT YOUR TICKET, DESPITE THE INSTRUCTIONS ON THE MACHINE.** Place the voucher that you received from church under the "BAR CODE" scanner on the LEFT side (or bottom) of the machine to validate the ticket that you received when you entered the parking deck. SEE PHOTO #2 BELOW. If your stay is less than 4 hours, the amount due should change to "\$0.00 due" once you scan your voucher. If it doesn't, push the red "clear" button and repeat steps 5 through 8 again or try a different machine.
11. Once you have scanned the voucher, the validated ticket should automatically pop back out of the machine. Return to your car with both validated ticket and the voucher.
12. Drive down to the exit of the parking deck. YOU HAVE 15 MINUTES TO EXIT FROM THE TIME YOU VALIDATED YOUR TICKET.
13. Insert your validated ticket into the machine located at the exit to cause the gate to rise.
14. Exit the parking deck.
15. Discard the parking validation stub that you received at church in an appropriate trash receptacle once you have left the parking deck. The parking validation stub can only be used once even if you did not exceed the four hour limit.
